VINEYARD NOTES

From the famed vineyard formerly known as Keefer Ranch, we bring you the 'MCM88' Pinot noir; an exuberant Russian River single vineyard Pinot noir from the block originally farmed by Kosta Browne. Our boldest Pinot noir yet comes from a very special block in a very special vineyard now known as Perry Ranch. This addition to the Senses family stands apart from its' siblings with greater concentration and richness. We are very excited about this wine and have named it accordingly.

NAME

MCM stands for Max, Christopher and Myles and doubles for the roman numerals of 1900, which when added to '88 marks their birth year of 1988. Named appropriately for an exuberant single vineyard Pinot noir from the famed vineyard formerly known as Keefer Ranch.

WINE

"Medium to deep ruby-purple in color, the 2022 'MCM88' Pinot noir rolls out of the glass with expressive notes of chocolate covered cherries, wild blueberries, and camphor, plus fragrant underlying hints of lilacs, cloves, and cardamom. The medium to full-bodied palate delivers concentrated black and blue fruit layers with loads of floral accents and a velvety texture, finishing long and fragrant."
