Max & Lexi Thieriot planted this vineyard in 2016 after years of searching. This site is located five miles from the Pacific Ocean and experiences the coolest weather of all the Senses' vineyards. Platt Vineyard, de Coelo, and Steve Kistler's Occidental plantings neighbor the site.

WINE

"Pouring a nearly opaque purple/ruby, the 2021 Pinot Noir Bodega Thieriot takes on more depth and warming spices, with aromas of crushed pine needles, brambly blackberry, and lavender oil. Beautifully balanced and harmonious, this full-bodied red is weightless in feel and texture, with ripe tannins and seamless acidity throughout. Long on the palate, with notes of black raspberry, turned soil, and smoked tea leaf, it has a generous and open nature now but will certainly improve with a couple more years in bottle. Drink 2025-2040."
